

# Partner Alert List

*.....for companions who reside with sex offenders*

- \* Substance abuse in alcohol and drugs.
- \* Compulsive behaviors in eating, smoking or gambling.
- \* Interrupted sleep, reported insomnia, up all night, early riser.
- \* Depression, sadness or crying spells.
- \* Argumentative, verbally aggressive or physically abusive.
- \* Reported sexual fantasy involving children or rape of adults.
- \* Sexual misconduct as in affairs - excessive flirtation behaviors.
- \* Helping children to bed at night without supervision.
- \* Sleeping with a child who had a nightmare.
- \* Use of pornography.
- \* Excessive use of the computer, Internet, chat rooms or e-mail.
- \* Making contact with past target population groups or victims.
- \* Unusual focus on sexual activity, intercourse, or oral sex.
- \* A lack of emotional intimacy.
- \* Whereabouts unaccounted for extended periods.
- \* Car cruising - unexplained mileage.
- \* Erratic changes in behavior.
- \* Failure to follow parts of relapse prevention plan.
- \* Skipping or missing treatment groups or sessions.
- \* Change in child care supervision, exhibiting unusual favoritism.
- \* The offender provides sex education information for children of family.
- \* Visiting high risk places alone - as in malls, parks, playgrounds.
- \* Extended telephone calls to unknown persons.
- \* Use of 900 sex line calls.
- \* Inappropriate apparel - robe open, no underwear garments.
- \* Entering bedrooms or baths without knocking.
- \* Reported stress at work, is terminated, conflict with co-workers



- \* Problems maintaining work.
- \* Unusual religious habits or conversion to alternative group.
- \* Joins child or youth groups in neighborhood.
- \* Preoccupation with child's dress or personal hygiene.
- \* Offers to bathe child.
- \* Selects or suggest special clothing for child.
- \* Unsupervised contact with one child - or isolating youth from others.
- \* Reluctance to have friends - or to socialize with extended family members.
- \* Inability to account for money.
- \* Gives gifts, presents, favors to certain children without merit.
- \* Displays anxiety.
- \* Shows a lack of victim remorse or empathy.
- \* Offender regresses to childhood clothing.
- \* Marital conflict.
- \* Difficulty resolving problems with partner.
- \* A diminished interest in fun or activities.
- \* Exhibits stress, worry, problems of concentration.
- \* Mood swings.
